# Tour to Victoria B.C. and Butchart Gardens

Join the Portland Section for a scenic drive to Victoria B.C., a tour of the Butchart Gardens, and a treasure hunt with the MBCA Vancouver Island section on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. This will be a great drive to world-class gardens, with some excellent sight-seeing along the way.

**Friday, August 16<sup>th</sup>:** We will meet at 8:30AM at Lava Java in Ridgefield, Washington, located just north of Vancouver on I-5 at exit 14. The group will depart at 8:45AM, for a 2 hour and 45 minute drive north, exiting I-5 at Tacoma and heading through Gig Harbor and Bremerton. We will stop for lunch in Keyport, Washington at the award-winning Whiskey Creek Steakhouse (<http://www.whiskeycreeksteakhouse.com/>). Their menu features affordable sandwiches, burgers and salads, and Whiskey Creek was featured on Food Network's *Restaurant Impossible*. After lunch, we will stop nearby to tour the Naval Undersea Museum. Their mission is to preserve, collect and interpret naval undersea history. The museum features exhibits on submarine technology, diving, and includes one of the most comprehensive permanent display of torpedoes in the United States. Their web site is <http://www.navalunderseamuseum.org/>.

Departing the museum at 2:45PM, we will continue north to Port Angeles, Washington where we will drive onto the Coho Ferry for a 90 minute crossing to Victoria. The ferry departs Port Angeles 5:20PM, and our group will need to be in-line for the ferry by 4:20PM. We will arrive Victoria at 7:00PM, and drive to the James Bay Inn to check in.



## Recap: Detail Event at Gallagher Auto Spa



On Saturday May 18th one of our newest advertisers, Gallagher Auto Spa, hosted an event focused on Auto Detailing. Owner Scott Gallagher demonstrated to Portland Section members why taking your car to a professional detailer is worth it. Club member Barry Corno was kind enough to let Scott demonstrate on his 1983 380SEC, the same car featured in the March/April issue of *The Star* magazine.

Scott has equipment that measures the thickness of the paint and clear coat combined. He used the measuring tool before and after polishing to show how many mils he took off to get a deep shine. Even though Barry's car is well cared for and can make many of us feel as though we neglect our cars, Scott showed how under regular lights we could not see light scratches in the clear coat. Scott demonstrated this by working on one-half of the trunk lid then showed us with a special light how the scratches were evident on the side that was not worked on and how they were gone on the side he did work on.

It was a very interactive event, with our members asking Scott questions throughout the presentation. Club member Harry Cordon was the winner of a free Classic Detail, courtesy of Gallagher Auto Spa.

I can tell you from personal experience that Scott Gallagher is a friend to our club and has a sterling reputation in the automotive community. I encourage you to get your vehicle(s) detailed at Gallagher Auto Spa.

# Recap: Over 100 Members at LeMay Museum Tour



On May 4th, 18 cars and 36 members from the Portland Section journeyed north to Tacoma to tour the LeMay Museum and attend a detail clinic at Griot's Garage. Those joining the caravan from Portland included Ed and Viki Waite, Greg and Nancy Buechler and John and Toni Hoppes.

At the LeMay museum we parked our cars on the show field, along with Mercedes-Benz from Seattle, B.C. and Vancouver Island sections. A total of 60 cars and 108 members participated in the LeMay Museum/Griot's Garage weekend.

Docents escorted small groups of people into the museum to walk through the four floors of automotive exhibits. On display was an excellent cross section of classic cars, both American and European. The 1933 Mercedes-Benz 380SS, with coachwork by Erdman & Rossi, is one of the rarest Mercedes-Benz automobiles in the world. On the lower floors we found a 1972 Mercedes 300SEL – not that rare but a great example of a W109 chassis. For me, it was a real treat seeing the museum's 1948 Tucker Torpedo. Conceived by Preston Tucker, only 51 were built. With an engine in the rear and other advanced safety features, it was way ahead of its time.

After the tour of the museum, many MBCA members enjoyed dinner at BJ's Brewhouse. With summer-like weather, it was a perfect end to a great day. Thanks to the Seattle Section for hosting this event!

# Griot's Garage Hosts Portland & Seattle Sections

Detailing our Mercedes was the perfect way to wrap up the LeMay Museum weekend event on a perfect Northwest spring day with temperatures reaching the 80's. Living in the NW one always takes advantage of top down weather to really enjoy our SL's. The professional staff at Griot's Garage welcomed over 50 members from British Columbia, Portland and Seattle section's to demonstrate the Griot's method of detailing our Mercedes with their products. Receiving a club discount on products allowed many to restock their detailing inventory and learn techniques from the professionals at Griot's Garage.

A Mercedes 180 ponton sedan with original paint, with some oxidation was the perfect candidate to demonstrate the products available to detail this classic sedan. The right rear fender was the demo area to demonstrate the Spray-On wash, when the traditional hose and bucket is not available. Next, the "paint cleaning clay" process is used with Speed Shine to lubricate the surface as you remove contaminants that even polish can not get out by lifting it off the surface. The process safely removes and cleans the surface prior to polishing/waxing the car.

Using the electric random orbital power polisher, the fender was polished using a fine polish and members learned the proper techniques/steps to use the polisher and various products to remove tiny scratches and oxidation in the paint, bringing the finish back to the original factory finish luster. To protect the polished surface, the Premium Carnauba paste wax was applied by hand using a wax applicator. Wait about 15 minutes and buff off with a micro fiber towel. What an easy on and off process with the wax. I added a container to my inventory of detailing products.

Once your car is detailed, and to maintain the just waxed look, various products were demonstrated to enhance the just waxed look for months. Two products, I use on my daily drivers are the One Step Sealant that holds up for about 9-

12 months and Speed Shine used after the Mercedes are washed.

We moved to maintaining/cleaning wheels on a 1990 500SL, using a variety of products available.

Members had the opportunity to use the electric buffer to get the feel of using an electric buffer on the car to use the polish and wax products. Many valuable tips and tricks of detailing were discussed and demonstrated in maintaining your Mercedes finish

Most members stocked up on detailing supplies at the Griot's store. This store is a guy's store, period... What a great session with members from BC & Portland attending, and meeting new Mercedes members from the NW region.
